The 28th Annual Conference of CGCA® will take place at the University of Düsseldorf from Friday 10 June to Saturday 11 June, 2016. The theme of the annual conference is "*Chemistry Meets Tomorrow's Challenges*". Many scientific sessions, including invited and oral report sessions, a poster session, as well as a special session of industry and career will be presented.

The latest and the most exciting aspects concerning chemistry and related areas will be discussed, and renowned chemists and industrial representatives will be present. The invited speakers include Prof. Dr. Christoph Janiak (University of Düsseldorf), Prof. Dr. Baolian Su (University of Namur), Prof. Dr. Fangxing Yang (Helmholtz-Zentrum für Umweltforschung), Dr. Gang Wei (University of Bremen), Dr. Zhenglong Zhang (Leibniz-Institut für Photonische Technologien) and Dr. Yucang Liang (Universität Tübingen). In addition, the **2016 CGCA Lubrizol Young Researchers Award** will be awarded.
